Subfloor preparation in a box

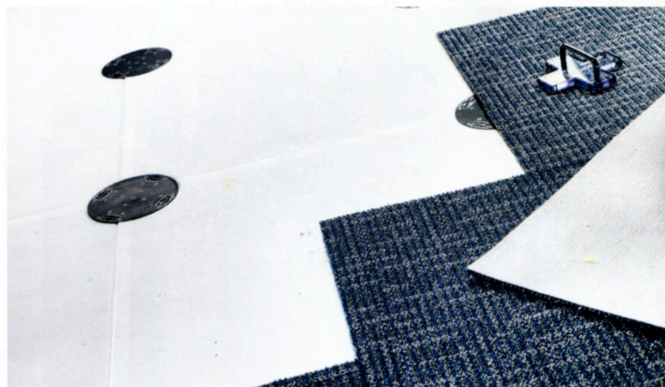
Fitters and contractors can avoid the time-consuming and expensive problems posed by poor-quality subfloors with the TacFast mechanical fix system.

"Floor preparation issues often crop up if a subfloor is in poor condition, and the associated costs with restoring it to a workable level can often spiral out of control, especially for budget-conscious projects, explains Jonathan Stone, chief commercial officer for TacFast Systems International.

Requiring no adhesives, TacFast eradicates any lengthy drying times or unpleasant fumes, and critically, it works with almost all types of floorcoverings, including wood and laminate planks, carpet tiles, ceramics, natural stone and LVT.
